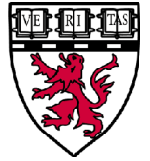




Brain Structure and Function After the Fontan Operation



If you are from 10 to 19 years old and have had the Fontan Operation, you might be eligible to participate in an important research study* at Children's Hospital Boston on neurologic (brain) and developmental outcome in teenagers who have undergone the Fontan Operation.



If you participate in this study:

- You will undergo testing of your learning style and behavior.
- You will complete questionnaires about you/your family.
- You will have a magnetic resonance image (MRI) of your brain.
- You will get results of your tests.
- Testing will take a total of 9-11 hours over one or two days.
- You will be paid (up to \$300) for your time and expenses.
- Your lunch and travel costs will be reimbursed.
- You have not celebrated your 20th birthday yet.
